A terracotta color ceramic vessel or vase, half cylinder shape with cream floral motifs. Yorkshire slipware refers to a type of decorated earthenware pottery made in the

Yorkshire region of England. "Slipware" means it was decorated with "slip"—a liquid mixture of clay and water that can be trailed, painted, or poured on the surface.
