



## Goat pulling cart thimble holder

### Date

### Primary Maker

### Medium

Metal, shell, ivory?, paint

### Description

The thimble holder (a) is made to look like a cart with a goat pulling it. The cart body is a piece of pearly shell that is attached to a set of metal wheels. The cart holds

an ivory-like thimble (b) with three fine bands of color---two gold and one black.

### Dimensions

Assembled:  $1 \times 1 \frac{1}{4} \times 2 \frac{3}{4}$  in. ( $2.5 \times 3.25 \times 7$  cm) b). Thimble:  $\frac{11}{16} \times \frac{9}{16} \times \frac{9}{16}$  in. ( $1.75 \times 1.5 \times 1.5$  cm)
