Place and Date Made; Wonogiri, date unknown; acquired by Ki Purbo Asmoro in Sukoharjo, 1996 In Java, Brama is a strong, determined, handsome - and hot-tempered - god. His state of meditation is so intense that he is said to actually disseminate heat and he is sometimes referred to as the god of fire. Mt Bromo is a volcano in Java named for this god. In India, Brama is the

god of creation. Brama is known for his role in Mahabharata episodes such as "Wisanggeni Lahir" (The Birth of Wisanggeni), "Ciptoning" (Arjuna's Deep Meditation), and "Kangsa Adu Jago" (Kangsa Puts Forth an Opponent)."
