A Koshula (or Košulja) is a traditional Balkan garment, often a long, embroidered cotton dress or chemise worn by women, particularly prominent in Macedonian, Serbian, and other South Slavic folk costumes, serving as a base for elaborate bridal wear, often featuring rich colors, patterns, and paired with vests (like the Saja) for special occasions.
